*Ask
Virginia...*

Many of you in the CAPS Community ask excellent questions. I answered a client's question below...

Question:

I have a glass stove top. It is fairly new. Can you give me information on how to clean it? Scratches will really show up on this type of stove.

Virginia's Answer:

Use a cleaner that is made for a glass cook top to avoid etching the surface.

One product that CAPS has had good experience with is the Weiman Glass Cook Top Cleaner. First, spray an all-purpose cleaner over the glass top and use a newer razor blade (hold at an angle) as you gently scrape off the food matter. You must keep the glass top wet when you use the razor blade, to avoid scratching the glass. Also, never use a razor that has any rust on it! After you have removed the matter off of the glass top, then finish cleaning and buffing the surface with the Weiman Cook Top Cleaner. I recommend that you use a gentle Microfiber cloth. Your glass cook top should sparkle when you are finished cleaning it using this method.

Recipe: Cornmeal Pancakes

When I was growing up, my parents would make homemade cornmeal pancakes. I really liked them because they get crispy on the outside and around the edges, while they remain soft on the inside. My favorite topping was maple syrup.

Ingredients:

1-1/2 cup cornmeal	3 Tbsp. sugar
1 cup flour	2-1/2 cups buttermilk
1 Tbsp. baking powder	1/4 cup vegetable oil
1 tsp. salt	

Preparation:

- 1) Mix ingredients together until blended.
- 2) Cook in a frying pan for approximately five to six minutes.
- 3) Flip the pancakes to cook on both sides, until crisp and lightly browned.

Servings: It depends on the size of the pancakes you want to make. This should serve three to four people.

Serving Suggestions: You can serve these pancakes with fruit on top - my favorites are blueberries or strawberries - or pour your favorite syrup on them... As mentioned above, my favorite is maple.
